After 8 years of touring the rivers and seas of Europe, the *Caravan Stage Company*, with the Tall Ship, *Amara Zee*, is back in America. BBC Chartering, an International shipping company sponsored the return transportation of the 30-meter ship from Italy.

The *Amara Zee*, the custom-built theater ship, was originally built in Canada. Before heading overseas, the company toured and performed in cities and towns throughout the Atlantic seaboard, Great Lakes, and Gulf of Mexico...as well as small villages and communities that are not even on the official maps!

The Caravan directors, Paul Kirby and Adriana Kelder are excited to be back. The Caravan is a non-for-profit professional company that has performs original contemporary spectacles on their theater ship while the audience sits on the shore.

Artistic Director, Paul Kirby says: "The Caravan European Odyssey has been thrilling and exhilarating adventure but we are delighted to be back in North America."

After spending the winter in Lafitte, Louisiana, the company traveled along the southern ICW, through the Gulf of Mexico, to bring the *Amara Zee* to Jacksonville, FL. The cast, coming from all around the world, joined the sailing crew at the end of April. Since then, a team of 38 people: performers, set builders, mask makers, fabricators, costumers, riggers, sound and light engineers, organizers, led by Paul Kirby and Adriana Kelder, are busy at the Metropolitan Park and at *JaxHax Makerspace* creating the new show.

'HACKED: The Treasure of the Empire!' is a tale of pirate activists who, through virtual and creative manipulation, battle the corrupting icons of our past and present world. The story will be told through song, aerial acrobatics, video and large puppet heads perched up high in the rigging of the 100 ft ship.

Hacked features the entire pallet of Caravan theatrical treats such as passionate characters, poetic lyrics, exotic and melodic music, multiple video screens with a global array of imagery and visual trickery, unique aerial acrobatics, surreal lighting and sound, and large puppets that spies, swags, savages, swears, swoons and sings.

This summer, the Caravan Stage Company will be touring the eastern coast of the US from Jacksonville FL up to Canada. Many stops along the way, including Portsmouth VA, Bivalve NJ, Yonkers NY; in Canada: Brockville ON, Kingston ON, Cornwall ON & Sainte Anne de Bellevue (Montreal); back down the Hudson River to Burlington VT, Hudson NY, Kingston NY. The tour will end in New-York City at the end of September.
