After 8 years of touring the rivers and seas of Europe and the Balkans, the *Caravan Stage Company*, with its Theatre Tall Ship, *Amara Zee*, is back in America. The Caravan is a not-for-profit professional company that performs original experimental spectacle theatre with contemporary thematic content on their 90ft theater ship while the audience sits on the shore.

BANNED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

The Caravan was founded in Canada in 1970 and has been "flying" the Canadian Flag ever since, whenever and wherever it performs. 
